Gents Competitions Communication Notice

- Members should not tamper with the competition computer and cables. If a player should notice a problem, please advise a Director or match sub group member ASAP (See names listed on match notice board).
- Members should only put their **own name and membership number** on the entry sheet for a Major competition.
- For Major Competitions, once the draw is made, it will be laminated so subsequent withdrawals or late entries **can only be** made through the pro shop.
- It is the player's responsibility to enter their scorecard into the computer before submitting their card into the scorecard box.
- Scorecards must be returned in the scorecard box with all competition details inserted in a legible manner complete with signatures.
- Scorecards not signed or not in the box when the competition is 'closed off' will result in players being **disqualified** from the competition.
- Any enquiries regarding the competition played or handicap updates from the competition should be directed to the members of the Handicap Sub Committee that closed off the competition. See bottom of competition result for names.
- From the start of 2015 season, for Medal rounds players are required to **enter their start & finish times** on their score card.
- Members are advised that with the use of the Electronic Starting system, slow play is being monitored.
- **A round at Kingsknowe should be no more than 3.5 hours.** Members are reminded to respect the etiquette of the game and keep up with pace of play.
- With regard to slow play, KGC will adopt the principles of "Ready Golf" in order to maintain the good work already done by members in this area. Please see the "Ready Golf" notices for further details.
- 5 days medals are only for 5 day members with effect from 2015 season. Consequently from March 2016, **5 Day members may not** play in Full Member Midweek Medals.
- Members can download their own handicap certificates directly from the KGC website.
- Members should make themselves familiar with the Supplementary Scores System process being adopted at KGC if they intend to use this facility.
- From April general play is permitted from the Blue tees for Gents and the Yellow tees for Ladies. The Gents White tees may only be used in Medals and for Supplementary Scores (if chosen).
