Kingsknowe Golf Club Super Winter League

RULES AND MATCH GUIDANCE NOTES 2017/2018

The Winter League will run weekly from Saturday to Friday usually to the last Friday in March.

ENTRY

An entry fee of £4 must be paid prior to entry. The weekly fee of £1.00 must be paid to the Professional shop before starting each round. Your round details to be recorded on the starter sheet and the game played on the same day.

FORMAT

Scoring will be by Stableford System. Each player will be allowed his/her national handicap. Half strokes will be rounded up. Ladies will now play off the ladies stroke index.

Scores may be recorded for either the Outward or Inward 9 holes, as indicated on the starting sheet. 5 scores will count per team.

Members with an odd number handicap (1, 3, 5 etc) please note that you will get your stroke on the front 9 only. eg, if you play off 15 you will get 8 on the front 9 or 7 if you play the back 9.

SCORE CARDS

To assist the committee, please mark your card **clearly** with your **name, date played and team number**. Record your score at each of the 9 holes played on your score card.

All cards should be entered into the A/B box under the winter league competition. All cards to be signed by player and marker or player will be disqualified.

Last tee off time on Friday before 2.30pm to enable cards to be completed and in the box by 4.30pm. The Winter League Committee will make entries on the league board on the Friday night or during Saturday. Countbacks will be to the last 6 of the 9 holes played, then 3, 2 and 1 if there is still a tie.

Sweep Winnings will be paid into your account in the shop.

Please note:- this may change depending on number of entries

Weekly Class A (11 and under)

Weekly Class B (between 12 and 17)

Weekly Class C (between 18 and 36)

WINNERS WILL HAVE ONE POINT DEDUCTED FOR SUBSEQUENT VICTORIES.

At the end of the season, if there is a tie for the Best Individual Score, then attendance will be used.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITIONS

In the event of 50% of players failing to play, the team competition will be a non counter. However there may still be Class winners. The prize money will depend on how many players did enter.

If the course is officially closed while any player has taken a Winter League card, players must restart at the point where they finished, as per Rules Of Golf. If the course is not re-opened cards completed before the closure will be considered in terms of % of players played(as above paragraph).

Fairway mats must be in accordance with KGC rules. The winter rules laid down by the club will apply and references must be made to the notice board to see what these are for 2016/1017.

MATCHPLAY

If matchplay teams are equal in a matchplay tie, the next non counting members score will decide an outright winner

At the end of Matchplay Qualifier Rounds, the four teams with the most points will qualify for the semi-finals. In the event of a tie in the qualifying stages.
