## SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR USING HIRE AND RIDE-ON GOLF CARTS

### Please Note:

- Not more than two persons are allowed to travel in a hire golf cart
- These guidelines apply to all motorised golf carts/ride on buggies

### Golf Cart users **should**:

- Exercise extreme caution at all times, and particularly if the course is/has been wet
- Slow down on all slopes
- Take care and slow down on designated paths
- Avoid travelling **across** steep slopes
- Avoid unstable ground
- Be mindful of other golf course users
- Stay behind other players when shots are being played
- Observe directional and warning signs and notices

### Golf Cart users **should not**:

- Drive at excessive speed
- Drive a golf cart after consuming alcohol
- Take routes via steep hills when there is an alternative flatter route
- Drive on designated paths in the wrong direction
- Take a golf cart on to the course when it has been closed to golf carts/buggies
- Be driven within 2 metres of bunkers
- Be driven onto green aprons or tees
- Allow anyone under the age of 18 to drive the golf cart

### Disabled Persons Policy

The Club recognises that some users will have special needs and will require the use of single person ride-on buggies/carts in order to play, and will accommodate them on the course without special dispensation as long as users observe the Club rules. However, when the course, or areas of the course, are deemed unsafe for use by golf carts, due to disruption, works, weather etc, then closures will apply to **all** ride-on buggies/carts and will be enforced regardless of the user.

### HOLE BY HOLE SAFETY ASSESSMENT

HOLE	TERRAIN ASSESSMENT	GUIDELINES FOR GOLF CART USERS
1	Slope downhill from 1 <sup>st</sup> tee to the end of the fairway can be slippery.	Keep golf carts off the Green banks. Avoid bunkers round front of Green.
2	Steep slopes right & left sides of the fairway.	Keep golf carts on path provided in the middle and use the flat fairway.
3	Hill to the left from 2 <sup>nd</sup> fairway is steep and can be slippery.	Use the path to the 3rd tee from the rear of the Green, with care.
4	Steep path to the 5 <sup>th</sup> tee, and slope down to right of fairway.	Slow down on this path and stay away from this area in wet or frost.
5	Steep slopes left and right of fairway.	Keep golf carts on the fairway to avoid slipping.
6	Proceed with care.	Keep golf carts away from tee areas.
7	Slope down from the tee area.	Keep golf carts away from tee area to avoid slipping.
8	Dog leg up slope after tee area	Take care on up slope particularly in wet or frost.
9	Steep sloped valley down from tee and up to green can be slippery.	Extreme care advised when wet or frost.
10	Steep sloped valley down from tee and up to green can be slippery.	Slow down on the slopes, especially in wet or frost.
11	Steep slope down from tee to flat can be slippery.	Slow down on the slope. No golf carts past the front bunker.
12	Proceed with care.	Keep golf carts away from tee areas.
13	Dog leg left with fairway sloping right to left.	Proceed with care. Keep golf carts away from tee areas.
14	Dip in fairway after drive.	Proceed with care. Keep golf carts away from tee areas.
15	Slight valley after tee on way to Green.	Proceed with care. Keep golf carts away from tee areas.
16	Dog leg slope down to fairway can be slippery.	Slow down on the slope.
17	Slope down from tee with further steep slope up to the green can be slippery.	Slow down on the slope particularly when wet or frost.
18	Steep slope down from the tee and up to green can be slippery.	Slow down on the slopes particularly when wet or frost.
