



**LOCAL RULES: See notice boards for updated Temporary Local Rules**

- 1. Out of Bounds** (Rule 18.2a).
    - i) Beyond any hedge, wall, or fence bounding the course.
    - ii) Beyond the white posts to the right of the 2nd hole.
    - iii) Beyond the white lines/posts to the left and behind the 9th and 18th greens.
    - iv) In or beyond the ditch marked by white posts to the right of the 1st and 16th holes, and also beyond the white posts to the right of the same holes.
    - v) Beyond the white lines/posts to the right of and beyond the practice putting green at the 18th green.
    - vi) On or beyond the paths surrounding the Clubhouse.
    - vii) Beyond white posts defining Practice Pitching Area on right hand side of the 18th.
  - 2. Stones in Bunkers are Loose Impediments.** Relief is available under Rule 15.1. If the ball moves as a result of moving the stone, the player gets a **one stroke penalty** and the ball must be replaced.
  - 3. Immovable Obstructions** (Rule 16.1) Relief may only be taken if the obstruction interferes with your stance or the area of your intended swing.
    - i) Any artificial man-made obstruction (e.g. a bell, man made paths).
    - ii) Staked trees.
  - 4. Immovable Obstructions Close To The Putting Green** e.g. Fixed Sprinkler Heads (Rule 16.1).  
Free Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction under Rule 16.1. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a penalty area, and an immovable obstruction, or within two club-lengths of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of the ball, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows:  
When the ball is in the general area and there is interference by an abnormal course condition. The nearest point of complete relief should be identified and a ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area. The relief area is one club-length from the reference point. is not nearer to the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.
  - 5. Ground Under Repair** (Rule 16.1) **Play Prohibited**
    - i) Areas marked as GUR by blue stakes or enclosed white lines
    - ii) Plantations of young trees defined by blue stakes. See Notice Board for full details  
If a player's ball lies in such an area, or it interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, they may take relief under Rule 16.1. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.
  - 6. Greens Machinery**  
If a player's ball lies in a rutted mark or a deep depression made by greens machinery, the player may obtain relief under Rule 16.1.
  - 7. Dropping Zones**  
(Marked With Closed White Lines)
    - i) To the left of the 2nd green-A, player must use the dropping zone if their ball lies on the path, or path and/or the wooden rails interfere with their stance or the area of their intended swing.
    - ii) To the right of the 18th green-A, player whose ball lands on the practice putting green must use the dropping zone.  
In both cases, the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in the designated dropping zone.
- Penalty for breach of Local Rules:**  
**Stroke Play - General Penalty (Two Strokes);**  
**Match Play - Loss of Hole.**
